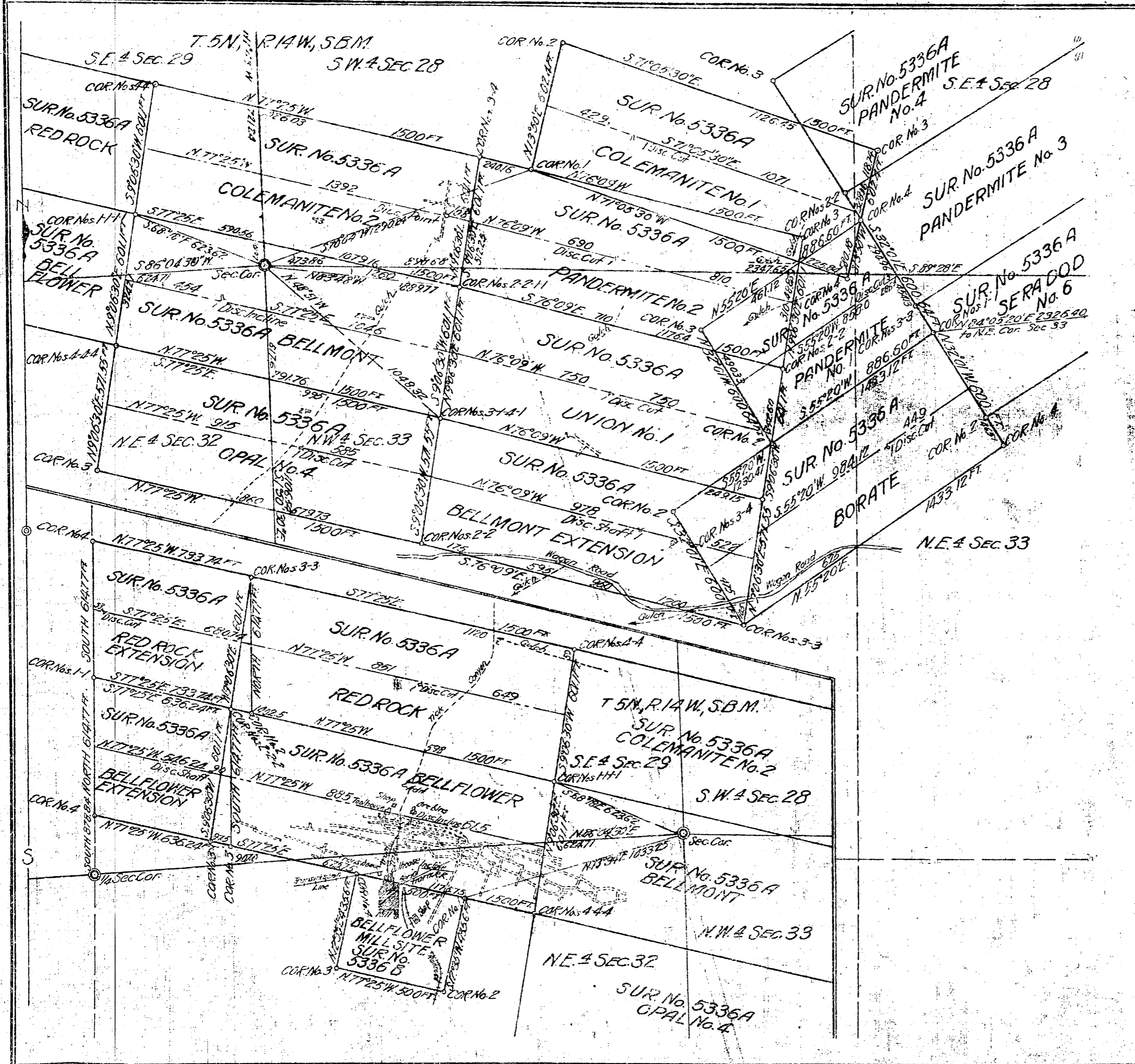

Stannels, line and derrick, shafts, crosscuts and drifts, level and adit, leadit and winze, lead, shaft and winze, tunnel and crosscut, level tunnel and crosscut, drifts, crosscuts and upraises. Value \$115,115.00 that the location of said improvements is correctly shown upon this plat, and that no portion of said labor or improvements has been included in the estimate of expenditures upon any other claim.
