...REMARKS...

Well was drilled to 120 ft. with spring-pole rig. At 30 ft. produced about two bbls. per day by sand pumping. This oil was in shale. At 120 ft. pumped 10 to 12 bbls. per day. In 1877 got an engine and deepened well to 600 ft. At 175 ft. it pumped 30 bbls. per day. In 1882 deepened again to 735 ft. but without any benefit. The best sand-rock was at 170 ft.
